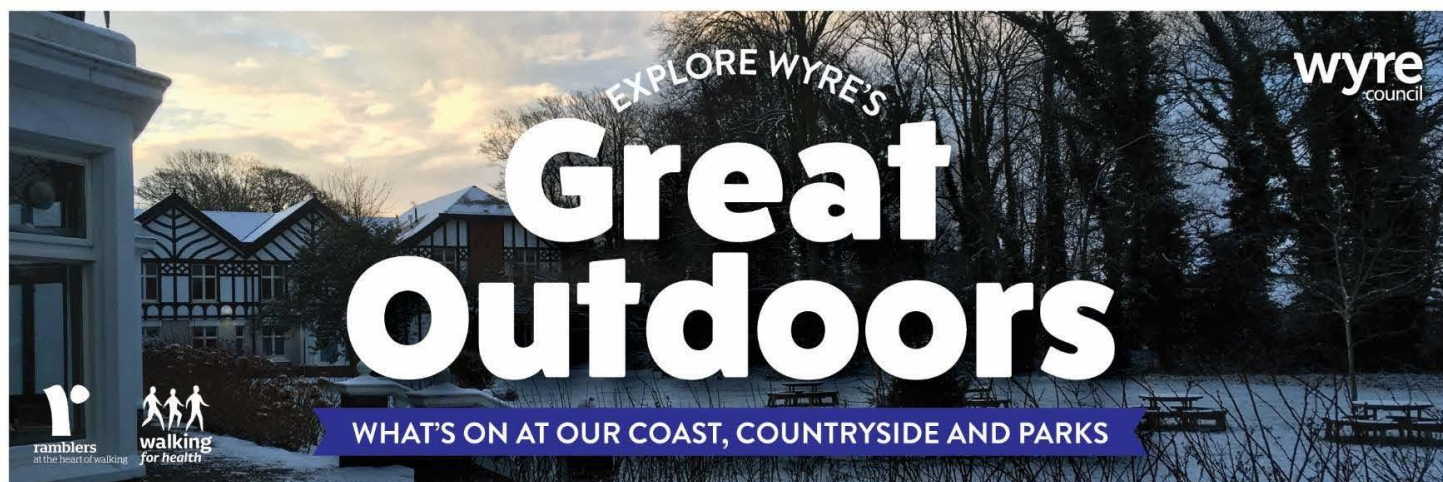


Great Outdoors Activities – January 2024

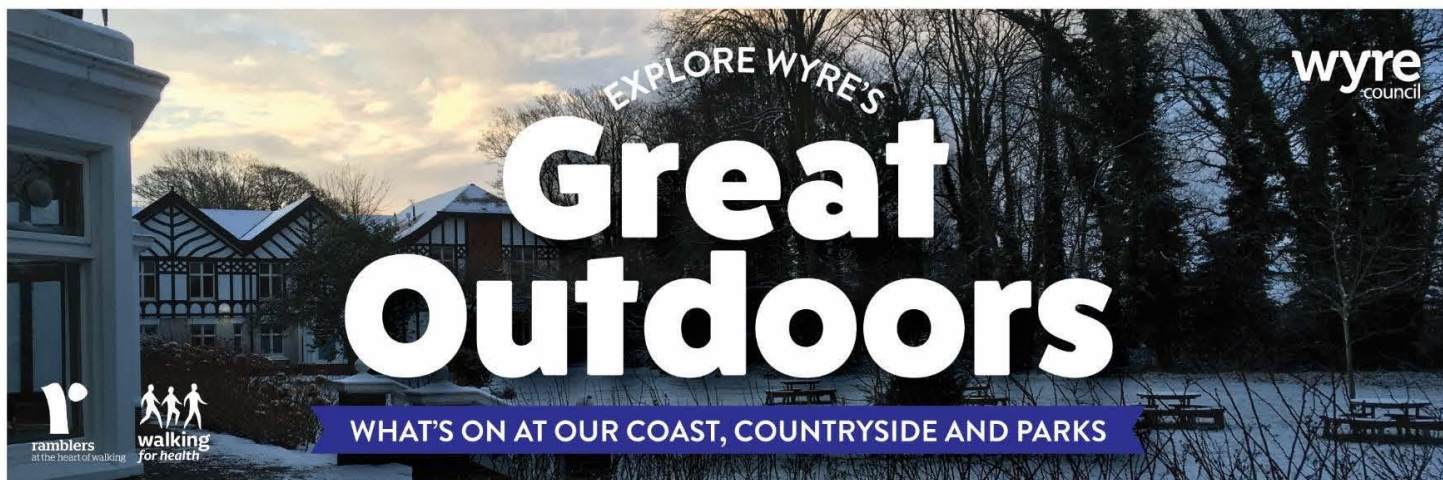

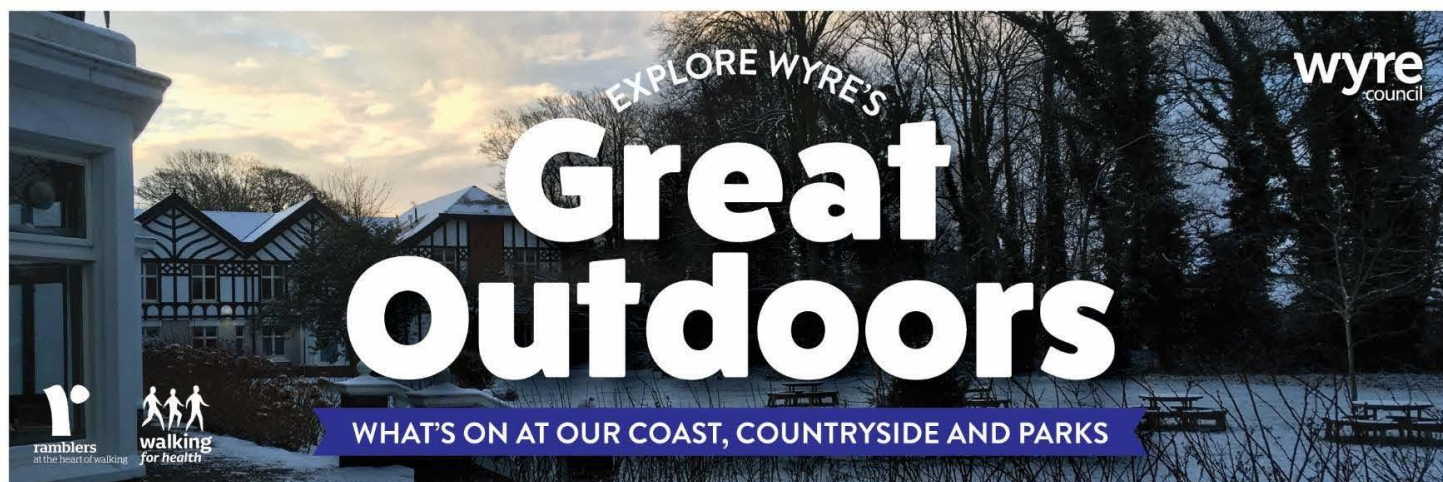
